PROTECT DISEWORTH - MISSION STATEMENT


To protect the community of Diseworth and the countryside that surrounds our village and which separates it from areas of existing and potential development.







THREE POTENTIAL FREEPORT SITES

An Open Letter

Proposed Development by SEGRO at Diseworth

As elected representative of the villagers of Diseworth, I give them my support in their opposition to planned development by SEGRO over 250 acres of agricultural land immediately next door to their village.

They recognise progress and growth require appropriate development but regrettably as planned this is not appropriate.

Initial indications are that SEGRO wants to develop an industrial zone involving floodlit 30metre-high warehouses with 24-hour lorry movements.

If allowed, the development will: -

- be far too close to the village, leading to a real risk of constant noise and light disturbance
- be on a significant slope and so particularly overbearing to this rural village and the surrounding rural countryside as well as visible from many miles away
- cover over several hundred acres of productive agricultural land
- be potentially damaging to the environment without appropriate mitigation in place

These are all important factors which need to be carefully taken into account by the decision makers when considering this application in due course.
